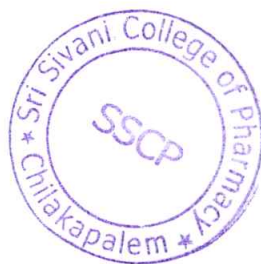

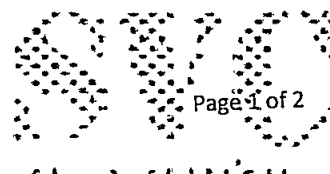

1. Developing research projects jointly and avail funding:

Both the parties agree to undertake research projects/activities through sharing of research ideas, data and academic resources that can lead to joint publications, development of any product or other intended outcomes like Intellectual property rights/ patents/discoveries generated out of the research activities, belonging to both parties. Such collaboration activities will also include joint research conferences, visitations and sabbaticals at each other's premises; subject to mutual consent of both the parties. 2. Exchange of academic information, materials and facilities

3. Students Exchange

3.1 Student Exchange Programs:

Both the parties agree to develop programs whereby the students of either organization can have the opportunity to study at the other organization with mutual recognition of the credit hours arising there from. It is desired by both organizations that there will be significant flow of students in exchange as reciprocal. Both parties agree to facilitate internship facilities for exchange students as mutually agreed. Pursuant to the specific agreement for academic exchange, KTPC and SSCP will exchange students according to the terms and conditions laid out by separate written agreement by both organizations.

3.2 Short Courses/ Summer School:

These courses, usually two to four weeks in duration, will normally be held in spring or summer as mutually agreed. In addition to various topics on industry operations and culture, the course would include meetings with industry executives, and visits to various industrial establishments. The cost and other terms of such programs will be mutually worked out separately each year.

4. Faculty and Staff Exchange:

Visiting faculty will be provided with opportunities to observe and share teaching methods and curriculum. 5. Advertising & Publicity:

6. Organizing/ participation in Joint symposia, seminars, conferences, workshops etc.:

7. Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment:

This MOU will be renewed upon its expiry, as per mutual agreement of both organizations. If either organization wishes to terminate the MOU at the end of the one years' period or in between the period of one year, it must notify the other organization not less than 30 days prior to the expiry of the MOU. The event of termination will not affect participants from completing their activities at the host party already initiated or ongoing unless otherwise mutually agreed. This MOU, its renewal and the actions taken under it will be reviewed at any time. Modifications to MOU will be made by mutual consent and any amendment or extension to the MOU will be formalized by the exchange of letters and or emails between the two organizations.

8. Resolution of Disputes and Governing Law:

In the event of any unforeseen issues or matters not covered herein or any controversy, dispute or difference arising out of or in connection with this MOU, the same shall be resolved amicably by both the organizations. This MOU and further agreements will in all respect be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Republic of India.

This MOU shall be signed in counterpart. Each counterpart will constitute an original document and these counterparts taken together, shall constitute one and the same MOU.

9. Tenure and Termination:

This MOU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for one year, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. 

Memorandum of Understanding

(Non-Financial)

This Memorandum of Understanding has been made and agreed upon between the parties mentioned below, signed on 15.02.2020 by and between the following two entities collectively referred to as "Parties" and each referred to individually as "Party".

Sri Sivani College of Pharmacy, here in after referred to as **SSCP**, has its registered office at NH-16, Chilakapalem Jn, Etcherla, Srikakulam-532402 represented by, SSCP after called as "First Party" which expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executors and administrators of the FIRST PARTY.

And

ACTIVE PHARMA LABS, Raja Enclave, #202, Bhagyanagar Colony, Opp: R.S.Brothers, Beside K.S.Baker's, K.P.H.B. Colony, HYDERABAD TG 500072 represented by its Head Operations herein after referred to as '**ACTIVE PHARMA LABS**' which expression shall, where the context so admits, mean and include its successors, representatives and permitted assigns of the other part.

Active Pharma Labs is a dynamic, rapidly evolving organization working to meet the needs of the Pharmaceutical and Health care industry as well as professionals and their patients. Active Pharma Labs support submitting DMF to US FDA, EU countries, Health Canada, TGA and other regulatory bodies, Submitting VMF to USFDA using eSubmitter tool, responding to the queries received from the agencies in a timely manner, Submitting CEP to EDQM, responding to the queries received from EDQM and getting CEP approval in timely manner.

WHEREAS Sri Sivani College of Pharmacy would be taking steps for the implementation of relevant programmes, mutually decided by both the parties, which would aim to enhance the employability of students by equipping them with Industry relevant skills.

AND WHEREAS Active Pharma Labs, through its Education & Training Initiatives will work closely with its members and Industry Associates to help improve the quality of the employable skills of students of **Sri Sivani College of Pharmacy**. In this regard, there are various Technical and Non-Technical training undertaken to meet this objective.

Now it is hereby mutually agreed amongst both parties to this MoU and bind themselves to the terms and conditions enumerated in succeeding paragraphs/Annexure A.

1. Purpose:

Both **SSCP** and **ACTIVE PHARMA LABS** have evaluated and considered its feasibility and agreed in rendering collaborations for the purpose of further enhancement of various activities such as

1. Training activities for students.
2. Faculty development programs to enhance the skills
3. Placements for SSCP eligible students
4. Training for Non-Teaching/Lab Assistants.
5. Industry visits and Knowledge sharing sessions from both the parties.
6. Internship for students.
7. M. Pharmacy project work/ thesis Works.

2. Scope:

- a. By virtue of this Agreement, other than **Sri Sivani College of Pharmacy and Active Pharma Labs**, no third party shall lay claim over the agreed activities.
- b. **Sri Sivani College of Pharmacy** shall render all assistance in engaging and will deploy its personnel as may be required for achieving the end of this agreement at the discretion of the Principles-SSCP.

3. ACTIVE PHARMA LABS shall engage its resources and infrastructure for training and placement activities as may be required for achieving the ends of this agreement at the discretion of the Principles of ACTIVE PHARMA LABS.

4. Roles and Responsibility

The principal roles and responsibility of the parties will be as set out in Annexure A.

5. Parties Shall

- a. Not use other party's Intellectual Property unless such other party consents to such use.

- b. Not to do anything which in the reasonable opinion of the other party is or will be harmful to the reputation of the other party.
- c. Keep each other informed of any matters relevant to the overall functioning.
- d. Share their expertise or any other information which would be of mutual benefit.

6. Financial Terms and Conditions

This will be a Non-Financial MoU where **SSCP&ACTIVE PHARMA LABS** will train the students by utilizing the available human resources and infrastructure by following the regulations of other parties.

7. Duration/ Term of the MoU

- a. The MoU shall begin from the date of its execution by the parties here to.
- b. This MoU shall continue in full force and effect up to **Three years** from the date of signing.
- c. Validity of this MoU shall be extended sufficiently early for further period/batches on Mutual agreement by the parties to the MoU.
- d. This Memorandum of Understanding is a document of good faith and Implementation of the MoU would be monitored on a yearly basis.

8. Termination

- a. Either party may terminate this MoU on mutual understanding by giving 3 (three) months' notice in writing served on other.
- b. The parties of the MoU understand that, where a course, as aforesaid, is under continuance, the termination shall take effect only on completion of the subsisting course.
- c. Save as otherwise set out in this MoU, the termination of this MoU howsoever arising is without prejudice to the rights, duties and liabilities of either party accrued prior to termination.

9. Confidentiality

Each party here to agree with the other:

- a. To keep information in strict confidence and secrecy.
- b. Not to use the information save for complying with its obligations under this MoU.
- c. Not to disclose the same to a third party other than the party's professional advisers and such employees of the other party on a need to know basis as per requirements of this MoU, who are

under a similar duty to protect confidential information, or any third party having a legal right to obtain disclosure thereof.

The restrictions contained in above clause shall apply to both the parties during the term of and for (one) year after the termination of this MoU but shall cease to apply to information or knowledge which:

- Has in it's entirely become public knowledge otherwise than through any unauthorized disclosure or other breach of such restriction.
- The other party has consented in writing to the same being disclosed.
- Is or has been independently developed by the other party without reference to or use of the confidential information.

Each party designates the single point of contact person (SPOC), **Mr. U. Sri Venkatesh**, Associate Professor, Training and Placements of Sri Sivani College of Pharmacy form **FIRST PARTY** and **Mr. K. Rambabu**, Director **ACTIVE PHARMA LABS**, Hyderabad.

Dispute Resolution

Any disputes and differences whatsoever arising under or in connection with this MoU will be settled by parties through negotiations, with in the period of thirty (30) working days from the service of the notice. This agreement will remain in effect for the period offive years, unless terminated earlier by either institution.

Notwithstanding the above, the period of this co-operation will, if necessary be extended with consent in writing from the parties
